Current volunteer opportunities: Southern Greece



An exciting and unique opportunity to participate in the innovative and essential work that RefuComm is undertaking has arisen in Greece.

We are looking for volunteer assistants to aid our partner '**One Quiet Warrior**' (OQW) with the awesome tasks involved in bringing vital information to the people trapped in camps in the Southeast of Greece. This includes showing our animated videos explaining the asylum process, see here:

You will be based in South-eastern Greece and travelling by van each day to various refugee camps that have agreed to allow us to help their residents by showing our videos, where you will set up the

equipment for the video screenings and workshops and assist in fielding any questions the refugees may have concerning the asylum processes and how they can prepare for their relocation, family reunification or asylum interviews. Yes, you'll get to play with the kids too, make friends with some of the residents, meet other volunteers who are doing terrific work, and even swim in the sea after your day is finished!

Requirements

Please read the role profile below and consider your character, experience and skillset and honestly and determine if you have what it takes to be a RefuComm volunteer. Life and work in the field is certainly not a cakewalk. It can be emotionally difficult, there are often hardships, things don't always go to plan, and it's definitely not a five-star hotel experience. BUT it is also highly rewarding, fulfilling - and could change the course of your life.





We expect RefuComm volunteers to be:

Team players, Flexible, patient, adaptable, compassionate, respectful, tolerant of cultural differences, helpful, reasonable, calm, creative, solution-oriented and resourceful. We are a small 'grass roots' organisation so you must be able to fund your own trip. You need to know how to manage your expectations, take direction well, have a strong and efficient work ethic, understand how to communicate appropriately, get along with others, take responsibility for yourself, your habits and your behaviour, be willing to ask a lot of questions, professional in all that you do and be prepared to do what's in front of you.

- To be treated with courtesy and respect
- Continuous training and feedback on agreed tasks
- To develop your skills and learn while on the job
