



FULL REGISTRATION – QUESTIONS YOU MAY BE ASKED

There are many stages in the of the asylum procedure in Greece and sometimes it is difficult to know what to expect at each stage. The full registration appointment is NOT your interview for asylum, relocation or reunification, but it is an opportunity for the Greek Asylum Service to find out more about you, your personal circumstances and your history. It's also your opportunity – if you have not done so at pre-registration – to tell the Greek Asylum Service about any vulnerabilities you may have. It is very important to tell the truth when asked questions by the Greek Asylum Service.

Here are some examples of the types of the questions you MAY be asked at full registration – if you have documents that support your answers, then you should bring them to the full registration appointment.

- 1) What is your family name and name of the applicant?
- 2) What are the family names and names of both sets of parents?
- 3) What is your nationality, or in cases of stateless person, your country of former residence?
- 4) What is your date of birth?
- 5) What is your place of birth (country/town or village/county)?
- 6) What is your place of last residence before your departure?
- 7) What is the relationship to the main applicant (for the family members)?
- 8) What is your religion?
- 9) What level of education do you have?
- 10) What was your profession in your home country?
- 11) What is your civil status? Are you single, married, divorced, widowed/widowed?
- 12) What was your family name before marriage (for women mainly)
- 13) What is the name of your spouse and is he or she living in Greece, in a third country or in other EU country?
- 14) What are the names of your children and their dates of birth? Are they living in Greece, a third country or another EU country?
- 15) What about your adult children? Do they have any disabilities, either mental and/or physical?
- 16) Do you have any other relatives (especially parents or siblings) living in Greece, in a third country or in other EU country?
- 17) Are any of your relatives seeking asylum dependent upon you and if so, why?

- 18)** Are you an unaccompanied minor?
- 19)** What are the contact details of the guardian of the unaccompanied minor? ?
- 20)** What is their landline telephone number in Greece?
- 21)** What is their mobile telephone number in Greece?
- 22)** What is their e-mail address?
- 23)** What is their profession in Greece?
- 24)** What is their employment address in Greece?
- 25)** Do you have a need for shelter?
- 26)** When did you leave your country?
- 27)** Tell more about your itinerary to Greece?
- 28)** Why you did not stay in one of the countries you have stayed/transited before entry into Greece?
- 29)** What was your date of entry into Greece?
- 30)** What was your exact place of entry into Greece?
- 31)** Do you have passport?
- 32)** If you do not have a passport, why not?
- 33)** Do you have other documents proving your nationality?
- 34)** Have you ever had visa for Greece or other EU country in the past?
- 35)** Have you even visited Greece or other EU country?
- 36)** If your answer is yes, which country?
- 37)** How long did you stay there for?
- 38)** Have you asked for asylum in Greece in the past?
- 39)** Have you asked for asylum in another EU country in the past?
- 40)** Have you asked for asylum in any other country in the past?
- 41)** Have you ever had a residence permit in Greece?
- 42)** Do you have any medical problems?
- 43)** If the answer is yes, for how long have you suffered these medical problems? When was it diagnosed? Are you undergoing treatment for this medical problem? If the answer is yes, please describe the treatment. Do you have the contact details of your doctor in Greece? Are you pregnant? How many months pregnant are you? Have you had any problems with the pregnancy until now? Have you had medical assistance in Greece?
- 44)** Can you explain why you left your country ? Please give a short summary of the reasons.
- 45)** Have you ever been convicted for any criminal offence?
- 46)** If the answer is yes, when? By which Court? What happened?
- 47)** Have you ever been accused of a crime in any country for which the proceedings are pending?
- 48)** Have you ever worked for:
- the national armed forces/non-state armed forces
 - the government
 - any public agency
 - the judiciary
 - the press agencies
 - the security agencies (national/private)
- If yes, please provide the name, department, position and dates.
- 49)** At your asylum interview, would you prefer a male or female interviewer?
- 50)** Do you have documents you wish to submit?
- 51)** Would you like to add and/or correct any of the asylums declarations you have already made?
